### Three Options For Your Life

- **WASTE** - On what Thoreau would call the trivialities and sham parasites of life!
- **SPEND** - Spend it on homes, experiences, fashion, etc.
- **INVEST** - The best use of your life is to invest it in something that will outlast it - God's Kingdom and the Good of others.

### The Big Idea

*A disciple should be generous with their time, talent, and treasure because everything has been given to them by God for their enjoyment, for the furtherance of God's Kingdom, and for the good of others.*

### 7 Principles For Investing My Life

**I. OWNERSHIP:** Everything I have belongs to \_\_\_\_\_. *Psalm 24:1; Matt. 6:19-21. 33-34; Matt. 25:14*

**II. ALLOCATION:** God has given me some \_\_\_\_\_. *Math. 25:15*

**Lesson:** The amount differs, but \_\_\_\_\_ gets something! *Romans 12:6a*

**III. ACCOUNTABILITY:** God \_\_\_\_\_ me to use my talents. *Math. 25:19; Romans 14:12*
