
## Welcome to Parkview Church

## I. BETRAYAL FROM WITHOUT

A. Jesus before the Roman soldiers: Late Thursday, Early Jewish Friday (Mark 14:41-50; John 18:1-3)

Verdict after Arrest: Jesus is Lord

#### B. Jesus before the reliaious courts

(Mark 14:53-65; Luke 22:66-71; John 18:12-14)

• 1st Trial: 3AM Friday morning, House of Annas, Hall of Justice

- 2nd Trial: 3:30AM Friday morning, House of Caiaphas
  - o This mockery proved the innocence of the accused and the guilt of the accusers.
  - o God took an unfair trial, held by unrighteous people, and used it to accomplish His perfect will.
  - o Lesson: Somebody can treat you unfairly, but it doesn't keep God from treating you fairly. God is always righteous.

Verdict after 2nd Trial: Jesus is innocent. God is righteous.

### II. BETRAYAL FROM WITHIN

A. Jesus before Judas: Wednesday-Friday (Mark 14:10-11: Luke 22:3)

#### B. Jesus before Peter: Early Friday

(Mark 14:66-72; Luke 22:54-62; John 8:10-11, 15-18, 25-27)

In the garden, Peter defends Jesus before soldiers and leaders, but in the courtvard, Peter denies Jesus before servants and slaves.

### **III. EXTRAVAGENT DEVOTION** (Mark 14:3-9)

A. Mary's love was one of costly preparation.

- B. Mary's love was an intentional decision.
- C. Mary's love was sacrificial.
- D. Mary's love was a love of action.

Verdict after 1st Trial: Jesus is innocent
